BIBLE STORY

Acts 15 - The Jerusalem Council

Some people in the church said Gentiles could only be saved if they followed the same rules as the Jews. Church leaders met together and agreed the good news about Jesus is for everyone. Jews and Gentiles are saved in the same way: by God's grace.



BIBLE TRUTH

Jesus is all we need to be saved from sin.



MEMORY VERSE

Philippians 1:6

"I am sure of this, that he who started a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."



TALK ABOUT IT

- Is a gift something you have to pay for or is it free? (*free*)
- Can a person be saved from sin by following the rules? Why not? (*No, we can never be perfect. Jesus was the only perfect sacrifice for sin. We can only be saved through Him.*)
- If being good doesn't save us, why should we still obey God? (*When we get to know who God is and how much He loves us, we begin to trust Him. We obey because we trust His plans for us are best.*)



PRAY ABOUT IT

Read Ephesians 2:8

Lord, thank You for living a life we could never live and dying so that we can be forgiven. Thank You for the free gift of forever with You when we believe. Help us to remember that You love us no matter what and there's nothing we could do that You can't forgive.



MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Pray for the students at camp to have a personal encounter with Jesus and to recognize that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. (John 14:6).
